## Meet Executive Director Jane Keiffer

*25 Years of service to the community*

Executive Director Jane Keiffer has spent a quarter of a century with Artemis Center, but she was not always sitting in the corner office. Upon graduating from the University of Kentucky with her master's in Social Work in 1995, Jane worked in Kentucky providing supportive services to children who experienced sexual abuse. One year later, Jane accepted a job as a court advocate with Artemis Center. She was assigned to Riverside Court and provided survivors with court accompaniment and advocacy within the criminal justice system. In one short year, Jane was promoted to Dayton Municipal Court Supervisor where she supervised three other advocates within Dayton Court. Jane continued to advance at Artemis and became the Hotline Supervisor, and eventually Clinical Director, a position she held for nine years.



## Becoming Executive Director

When there was a vacancy in the Executive Director position after a short tenure from the previous director, Jane reached out to select individuals to gain perspective and feedback on what it would mean to take on the responsibility of the new position. “I did not come to this organization with the intention to be Executive Director,” Jane says, reflecting on the moment. While it may not have been what Jane had in mind, the opportunity was there, and she had a big decision to make. Inevitably, it came down to her passion for the vital role Artemis plays in the Dayton community and her belief that she had more to give. Suddenly, Jane had an entire organization depending on her leadership.



That was four years ago, and Jane has continued to prove she made the right call. Throughout her years with Artemis Center, Jane says the most rewarding part is seeing clients increase their safety along with their children’s safety due to Artemis Center’s services. Equally rewarding, meeting, and developing friendships with many wonderful individuals in our community.
