CLIENT SUCCESS STORY

A A CARLES

A single mother of two children began working with Artemis Center for safety and supportive services in response to years of emotional and physical abuse meted out by her partner. After many months of navigating this dangerous situation, the client courageously pursued criminal charges against the abuser as part of her plan to move forward. To safeguard against future threats of violence, the client and children relocated to a home with a confidential address.

Unfortunately, with this move came the loss of many belongings she had purchased before the abuse started. Getting beds and bedding for her children was a large expense that was beyond her means, especially with the added costs of emergency relocation. When her advocate offered her the opportunity to use the Dayton Foundation's Basic Human Needs Grant, the client expressed relief and excitement to know that she could provide the comforts her children deserved during this stressful transition.

With this funding, the client was able to request mattresses, bed frames, and bedding for both children, and Artemis arranged for the items to be delivered to their door.



The first package to arrive at their home was a box of 4 pillows which her youngest son opened. The client stated that she was surprised and overwhelmed by her son's excitement when he hugged one of the new pillows and exclaimed *"I am so excited to have a pillow!"* She also shared in a message with her advocate that *"Jackson* received the sheets and pillowcases and did the 'Avengers' dance, it was so cute, silly, and awesome. Cassandra* also loved her bedding! Please tell everyone that we said thank you, and they were so happy with their new things. Thank you to all of you at Artemis, and everything you have done for us through this entire process!"*

This client success story mirrors so many of the survivors that were assisted through The Dayton Foundation Basic Human Needs Grant. Their stories shine a light on the fact that having access to a bed and bedding is often an overlooked resource especially for survivors of domestic violence. It is these basic needs that have a life changing impact on the lives of our clients and their children who have lost everything in the process of fleeing violence. Overall, this grant was an invaluable resource which greatly supported our mission of *"working with the community to empower survivors to heal and live free of domestic violence."*
